LG continues trickling details on its <u>upcoming smartphone flagship</u> -- the company promises the G6 features better sound through a 32-bit quad-DAC system.



Apparently such an addition allows for the independent control of each earbud, leading to clearer, more balanced sound. It also provides analog output, meaning the G6 will most probably feature a headphone jack. The DAC comes from audio chipset specialist ESS, and is described as an improvement over the quad-DAC found in the 2016 LG V20 smartphone.

Set for a Mobile World Congress 2017, the G6 features a 5.7-inch display with minimal bezels and an unusual 2:1 "Full Vision" aspect ratio. Construction is in minimalist glass and metal, and the device is said to carry a Qualcomm Snapdragon 821 CPU, dual-camera system and centre-mounted fingerprint sensor.
