

Samsung: Not Interested in Buying webOS

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Bloomberg reports Samsung will "never" buy webOS, CEO Choi Gee Sung tells the press at IFA 2011-- with Samsung spokesman Nam Ki Yung echoing the sentiment from Seoul.



The confirmation comes in response to analysts saying Samsung was planning to make a webOS deal with HP.

A number of analysts speculate Samsung is not the only company showing interest in the Palm OS-- Facebook and HTC might be planning to open their wallets.

Choi continues saying "it's not right that acquiring an operating system is becoming a fashion."
