

How to Protect iDevice Cables

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Customers worried about breaking Apple Lightning and 30-pin charging cables? Tudia provides a solution with Klip, a 2-piece silicon and polycarbonate clip one can snap onto iDevice cables for added protection.



According to the company the Klip reduces strain on cables by up to 80% by controlling bending at the most vulnerable points of the cable-- the ends. It also fixes frayed or damaged cables, allowing for continued use without need for fixing with tape or shopping for replacements.

The actual clip is small and light, and installation promises to be easy. One simply slides the silicone base on the cable until it meets the plug before attaching the white polycarbonate clip to lock the Klip in place.

The Klip is available in packages of 2 in a choice of 5 colours-- blue, green, pink, gray and yellow.

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
