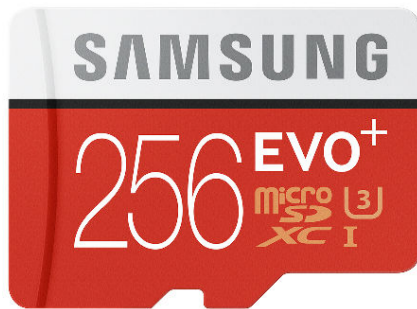


Samsung MicroSD Cards Go Up to 256GB
